## **Royal Tara Golf Club Juniors - Senior League Summer 2021**

The Senior League is for juniors playing 18 holes (level 6 category). Competitions will run in June, July, and August. Each week there is a combined competition for both boys and girls who have an official WHS handicap. Entry will be via the club's online tee reservation system (BRS), and competition fees will be collected via the BRS purse, €2 per competition. Juniors may need to top up their purse on BRS to book and prepay a time on the timesheet. Tee times from 1pm − 2:30pm, times to be booked in sequence from 2pm (no gaps). Prizes each week will be given out based on entries received. Prizes may include a gross prize in singles competitions and may include category prizes e.g. handicap category and/or best boy or best girl etc.

We are proposing to have a mix of competition types as follows:

Handicap allowance applies to Course Handicap. Golf Ireland app can be used to calculate WHS handicap index. Royal Tara Handicap Calculator app be used to calculate playing handicap for above competitions.

We will have weekly prizes and overall prizes for golfer of the year. Golfer of the year points will be awarded as following:

- 1. 1<sup>st</sup> place 3 points
- 2. 2<sup>nd</sup> place 2 points
- 3. 3<sup>rd</sup> place 1 point

Golfer of the year points will be calculated based on the best 6 out of 10 events. In the event of a tie we will go to the 7<sup>th</sup> best score and so on. All events including team events attract golfer of the year points. Results will be published weekly on the club website including leaders in the golfer of the year.

All singles will be in 3 balls and will count for handicap purposes, all singles for boys will be from green markers. All fourball and 2 person and 3 person teams can comprise boys and girls in the same team.

The course in play will normally be the main course i.e. blue/red.

A starter will manage tee off times. Juniors will eventually sign-in and enter scores in the locker rooms, but initially we may ask scores to be returned by sending a photo of the score card via Whatsapp. COVID-19 guidelines will be strictly enforced.
