COURTESY ON THE COURSE

Behaviour during Play

No one should move, talk, or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke. The player who has the honour should be allowed to play before his opponent or fellow competitor tees his ball.

Consideration for other players

No player should play until the players in front are out of range. In the interest of all, players should play without delay. Players searching for a ball should signal the players behind them to pass as soon as it becomes apparent that the ball will not easily be found. They should not continue play until the players following them have passed and are out of range. When the play of a hole has been completed, players should immediately leave the putting green.

PRIORITY ON THE COURSE

In the absence of special rules, two-ball matches should have precedence and can be entitled to pass any three or fourball match. A single player should give way to a match of any kind. Any match playing a whole round is entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round. If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front, it should allow the match following to pass.

Members are reminded that the above rules apply not only in competitions but also in friendly matches.

CARE OF THE COURSE

Bunkers

Before leaving a bunker, a player should carefully rake the area disturbed while entering, playing and exiting.

Restore Divots and Plugmarks

Through the green, a player should ensure that any turf cut or displaced by the player is replaced at once and pressed down, and that any damage to the putting green made by the ball or the player is carefully repaired.

Damage to Greens -

Players should ensure that, when putting down the flagstick, no damage is done to the putting green, and that neither they nor their caddies damage the hole by standing close to it, in handling the flagstick or in removing the ball from the hole. The flagstick should be properly replaced in the hole before the players leave the putting green.

CADDIE CARS

Local Notices regulating the movement of caddie cars should be strictly observed.

Practice on the Course

No player may play more than two balls while practising on the Course.

Damage through Practice Swings

In taking practice swings, players should avoid causing damage to the course. particularly the tees, by removing divots

BUGGIES

Please refer to the policy document in the Club regarding the use of buggies in the winter months.

RULES GOVERNING MENS COMPETITIONS

- Members participating in club competitions MUST USE BRS for entry and payment to the competition. On completion of the round, scores must be entered on the computer by the competitor.
- 2. Cards must be completed correctly and legibly, showing handicap, date and name of competition.

 Cards must be signed by the competitor and countersigned by the attester, who has completed the round with the competitor, before leaving the course. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the competition. This rule also applies to General Play Rounds for both Card and/or Digital score submissions to WHS database.
- 3. Those participating in official club competitions have precedence at all times. Competitions in the fixture list have precedence over club match play competitions.
- 4. All Official Competitions start on the first tee. An officer of the men's committee may, at his discretion, allow official competitions to start at the tenth tee in the event of congestion at the first tee. Players playing in official competitions coming through the ninth hole have precedence at all times over players starting with permission on the tenth tee.
- 5. The Committee reserve the right to alter times and/or pairings on any Time Sheet.
- 6 Players commencing play on the 10th tee of the
- competition course of the day should only do so if the ninth fairway is free.
- Mixed Foursomes Men and Ladies must have official club handicaps. Men must drive from the first tee in match play.
- Under local rule the max Handicap for visitors is 28 for men, Semi-Open Fourballs - Pairs must include one club member.
- Break of tie for 18 Hole Competitions: Last 9. Last 6. Last 3. Last 1. lst 9. Last 3, Last 6, Last 7, Last 8. lf

- 10. Golfer of the Year. The best 5 net scores returned out of the 7 counting competitions will determine Golfer of the Year.
- 11. In the current year, a member who does not return at least three singles cards before the Captain's Day will not be eligible to win the Captain's Prize. A member who does not return at least four singles cards before the President's Day will not be eligible to win the President's Prize or to win a Hamper. Members in their first 12 month of membership are excluded from winning first prize in the Captains and Presidents prizes, all members require a fully formed Handicap i.e., 8 out of 20 counting scores as per the WHS to win any of the club Major competitions.
- 12. No member may win more than one Hamper.
- 13. Special prize of an engraved plate/goblet for any member of the Club holing out in one, in official club competitions.
- 14. On the occasions when there are separate competitions on the 1st and 2nd nines, the following rule shall apply: Players having previously entered for 2nd nine-hole competition after playing 1st nine have priority on 10th tee.
- 15. A member may enter a weekly 9-hole Turkey Competition while playing in a weekend Turkey Competition.
- **16.** Any alteration to the Rules Governing Competitions will be posted on the Club Notice Board.
- 17. The Men's committee reserves the right to postpone, alter the conditions or declare any competition void.

RULES GOVERNING WOMEN'S AND JUNIOR GIRLS' COMPETITIONS

- Members participating in competitions must use the BRS to enter the competition and for payment. Members should sign in on the computer in the Locker Room before their round and enter their score on the computer on completion of their round. If the BRS is not being used or the computer is not working, members must enter their name in the Competition Book and place their entry fee in the box provided before play. If a player fails to comply with the conditions of entry, they are deemed not to have entered the competition.
- Cards must be completed correctly, and legibly, showing handicap, date and name of competition and must be signed and countersigned before leaving the course. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
 All cards must be returned whether completed or not.
- Those participating in official competitions have precedence at all times. Competitions in the Fixture List have precedence over Club Matchplay.
- 4. All official competitions start on the first tee of the course of the day. A member of the Women's Committee may, at their discretion, allow official competitions to start at the tenth tee in the event of congestion at the first tee. Players playing in official competitions coming through the ninth hole have precedence at all times over players starting, with permission, on the tenth tee.
- 5. All singles competitions shall be played in 3-Balls, where possible.
- 6. Break of tie for 18 Hole Competitions: last 9, last 6, last 3, last 1. If still a tie, last 3, last 6, last 7, last 8 of first 9 holes. If still tied, then by Lot. Break of tie for 9 Hole Competitions: last 6, last 3, last 1. If still tied, then by lot.
- 7. Major Competitions: All members require a fully

formed handicap, i.e., 8 out of 20 counting scores as per the WHS, to win any of the major competitions. Three completed single competition cards (Thursday Open Singles cards qualify) must be returned before a player is eligible to win the first major competition of the year. Four completed cards must be returned for a member to be eligible to win a second major. Five completed cards must be returned for a member to be eligible to win the Captain's Prize, President's Prize, Hamper 1 and Hamper 2.

- 8. No member may win more than one Hamper.
- 9. Golfer of the Year: The best 10 net scores returned out of the 10 GOY counting competitions.
- 10.An engraved trophy will be presented to any member of the Club, holing out in one, in official competitions.
- 11. Students and Junior Girls may play in all Club competitions, however in the four Major competitions and Hamper 1 and Hamper 2, they are only eligible to win category and gross prizes.
- 12. The Women's Committee reserve the right to postpone, alter conditions or declare any competition void.
- 13.A complete detailed list of competition rules and regulations is posted on the notice board in the Locker Room. Any alteration to the rules governing competitions will be posted on the notice board.

Rules governing male juvenile and student member competition and playing rules

- Juvenile and Student Members may play in all Club and Open Singles Competitions, excluding Club Matchplay tournaments.
- Student and Juvenile Members pay a reduced Fee in all Open and Club Singles Competitions, the fee is decided by the Men's Committee
- Student and Juvenile Members may win a Student/Juvenile Prize not exceeding 640 in value, should they feature in the overall field rankings. One Student/ Juvenile Prize only per competition, regardless if more than one Junior features in the overall field rankings.
- 4. Juvenile Members entering all Senior Club Competitions must be accompanied by an Adult Member. Juvenile Members may only book a place after 2pm in a Senior Competition held on a Saturday or Sunday on the BRS system after 6pm on the Friday before the Competition.
- 5. For Fourball and Team Competitions, excluding Hampers, Students and Juvenile Members are eligible to play in and win an Adult Prize once they have paid the full competition rate and are accompanied by an Adult Partner. It two Students/ Juveniles would like to play in a team together, they are eligible to enter the competition, for a reduced Juvenile Fee, but will only be eligible to win a Student/ Juvenile prize if they feature in the overall field rankings.
- 6. Student and Juvenile Members are not eligible to win Golfer of the Year
- Juveniles may not commence play on any 9-hole course after 7pm unless accompanied by an Adult Member
- Only one Juvenile Member per line is permitted to enter all Singles and Hamper Competitions unless agreed in advance by either the Hon Competition Secretary or Junior Convenor.
- Marking scorecards: After each hole the MARKER must check the score with the COMPETITOR and record it. The MARKER must put his own score in the MARKERs column after each hole. At the completion of the round, the MARKER hands the card to the COMPETITOR
- After the card has been verified and signed by the MARKER, the COMPETITOR may not change it
- 11. Student and Juvenile Members must clearly mark their Score Card with a large "S" or "J" when returning Score Cards in the Senior Competitions. Failure to comply with this rule will result in disqualification from the competition.
- The Men's Committee may amend these rules at any time and will inform the Junior Convenor in advance of implementation.

Student and Juvenile Member Regulations

- 1. Royal Tara Junior Members must display their Membership Tag clearly on their golf bag at all times
- 2. Junior Members must report to the Professional Shop to check course availability in respect of the competition course on the day.
- Junior Members wishing to use the practice facilities must first check with the Professional and then only Three Junior Members are permitted on the practice area at any one time
- Junior Members must give Adult Members priority on the first tee box except during competition times where the Junior Member has reserved a tee time

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR AVOIDING SLOW PLAY

Please play "Ready" Golf

- 1. Be ready to play at least 5 minutes before your appointed time.
- 2. Do not waste time on tees have your club. tee and ball ready when your turn comes to play.
- 3. Ask your partners to keep an eye on your ball and note its approximate landing area.
- 4. On the fairway have your club selected and your shot lined up, etc. while your partners are playing their shots. if possible.
- 5. Park your clubs/caddy car at the exit side of the green for easy access to next tee.
- 6. In Foursomes Competitions, be on the green ready to putt if required.
- 7. When it is obvious you have lost the hole (v Par) or cannot score (stableford) pick up your ball to avoid delay.
- 8. Do not mark cards around green mark them on next tee box.
- 9. Please read carefully Section on Courtesy on the Course (page 10 Fixture List) and implement same
